The screen was proven by the Curators of Alexander Palace to have originally come from the Palace and was used by the last Romanov Family. In fact the screen was made in Russia in about 1820-1825 and is made in mahogany and fabric. The mahogany frame is hand carved.

This beautiful screen adds to the huge quantity and variety of items we have purchased. The very first item we purchased was an oil painting of Nicholas II on horseback. This has been followed by a wide range of historical items from furniture, clocks, clothing belonging to the Imperial family, porcelain and much more.
